COURSE DESCRIPTION/INSTRUCTORS STATEMENT

This course will examine the social construction of gender and the key factors associated with the psychology of women, including gender role stereotypes, socialization and other issues relevant to women and girls such as gender-based violence, physical/mental health, the world of work, and aging.
