### COURSE DESCRIPTION/INSTRUCTOR'S STATEMENT

This course builds on the material covered in Organizational Psychology I (PSYC 2801), and is designed to provide students with a depth of knowledge in both classic (e.g., job attitudes, workplace socialization) and modern (e.g., career sustainability, 'coffee badging') workplace issues. The key aim of this course will be to equip students with the knowledge and skills required to identify and contribute to thriving workplaces.

The course will be offered online and will consist of synchronous meetings, in-class participation activities, online quizzes, written reflection(s), and on-campus examinations.
