### COURSE DESCRIPTION/INSTRUCTORS STATEMENT

This online course has been designed to introduce students to qualitative research approaches and to expose them to a wide range of qualitative research methods that can be applied to research in various sub-disciplines of psychology. Students will learn about the theoretical and philosophical underpinnings of qualitative research, but the emphasis of the course will be on hands-on learning whereby students will be able to experience the process of conducting a qualitative study from beginning to end. This course is best suited for students who are unfamiliar with qualitative research methods and would like to understand how this research approach could complement their quantitative program of research.

### EVALUATION

Students will be evaluated based on their progression through the weekly modules, which include self-assessment quizzes, forum discussions, and assignments. Students will also be evaluated based on their final project. This course has an experiential component where students will be asked to conduct by-weekly guided activities 'in the real world' to extend their knowledge and understanding of the topics addressed in the modules.

### TEXT

There is no textbook for this course. Students will be assigned readings from the published literature.
