- All prerequisites MUST be met before registration will be permitted.
- All students must have achieved 3rd-year standing (9.0 credits complete) or higher in a Psychology program (not open to Psychology minors).
- All students require a major CGPA of 7.0
- Here is the process:
 - 1. Submit this application to the Department of Psychology (practicumpsychology@cunet.carleton.ca)
 - 2. Receive departmental permission to register in the course. Seating is limited.
 - 3. Locate your placement.
- It is the responsibility of the student to locate a placement and a list of possible placements
 appears in the *Practicum InfoPack*. Students are welcome to propose placements that do not
 appear on this list. Either way, all placements must be reviewed and approved by the
 Department of Psychology. It is not necessary to have a placement confirmed before
 registration occurs.

However, students are encouraged to have confirmation as soon as possible. This is important because some placements are in high-demand, require a police check, or have other requirements that take time to satisfy.
