### COURSE DESCRIPTION/INSTRUCTOR'S STATEMENT

Topics discussed in this course include attraction, social cognition, communication, interdependency, friendship, love, sexuality, stresses and strains, conflict, power and violence, relationship dissolution, and relationship maintenance.
