

Exemption from Out of Province Tuition Fees

Instructions (please read carefully):

Students who have been identified as Out of Province Canadian students for the purposes of tuition fee assessment, but are eligible to claim Ontario residency can utilize this form to request their eligibility to be reviewed.

Note - only Ontario residents are exempt from Out of Province tuition fees.

Please carefully read this entire document and provide all requested information. Your request will be reviewed and the Registrar's Office will contact you to obtain the necessary supporting documentation via your Carleton email (CMail) account.

To be a resident of Ontario, a student is required to live in Ontario for a 12-month consecutive period without attending post-secondary studies (college or university). Residency can also be based on a parent's or spouse's residential history where the parent/spouse did not attend college or university.

By submitting this form, you are representing to Carleton University that:

- You have the consent of your parents and/or spouse (as applicable) to provide their personal information in this form;
- You understand that decisions made by the Registrar's office with respect to your eligibility review request are final and may not be appealed; and
- You understand that submitting false information in this form may result in disciplinary action under the <u>Student Rights and</u> Responsibility Policy.
