**COMP 1405 Z & COMP 1406 Z:** *The Z sections are taught following Carleton's schedule for half-term courses, with 1405 Z in the first half of the term and 1406 Z in the second half. These compressed sections are taught in half the time of the usual sections and students should expect to spend twice as much time on them each week.*

**Note: CO-OP Students** should progress in their courses sequentially as listed above but must **swap the courses scheduled for 3<sup>rd</sup> Year Winter and 4<sup>th</sup> Year Fall.**

### Free Electives

All courses offered by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, the Faculty of Public and Global Affairs, the Faculty of Engineering and Design, the Sprott School of Business and the Faculty of Science except for courses in the Prohibited Courses category. Free electives can include COMP, CSEC, DATA, MATH and STAT courses.

### Prohibited Courses
