## Policy on Rescission of Degrees

The Senate of Carleton University has delegated to Senate Executive the authority to rescind degrees that Senate has previously awarded. The decision to rescind a degree is subject to the following policy.

A degree may be rescinded in any of the following circumstances:

- The student was awarded the degree but either had not formally applied to graduate or had cancelled the application to graduate by the published deadline.
- 2. The rescission of the degree is all or part of a sanction imposed under the Student Academic Integrity Policy.
- 3. The rescission of the degree is all or part of a sanction in a case of non-academic misconduct where the sanction was imposed under the Student Rights and Responsibilities Policy and addresses an event that occurred prior to the awarding of the degree.

A degree will not be rescinded as a consequence of either:

- 1. An administrative error by the University that resulted in the student graduating without the full graduation requirements having been completed.
- 2. A request from the student that the degree be rescinded for personal reasons.
