Although too late to make changes to the 23/24 dates and deadlines, I need to make a change for future Academic Schedules.

Current:

March 1, 2023 Last day for graduate students to submit their supervisor-approved thesis, in examinable form to the department.

Proposed

April 1, 2023 Last day for graduate students to submit their supervisor-approved thesis, in examinable form to the department.

In all other terms, the date of thesis submission is approximately 1 month prior to the end of term, where in the Winter term, it is 2 months prior. I've consulted our team, and this may have been changed at some point to accommodate an early Senate date, however going forward, one month prior to the end of term is sufficient.

Too bad I missed this for 23/24, however I will be notifying Departments that in practice, we will be instituting an April 1 deadline for W22 and W23.

Please let me know if there is a more formal manner in which this future request should be made, or if this email is sufficient.
