The 3 candidates with the most votes are: **Winnie Ye, Cristina Ruiz Martin and Niall Tait**. Mostafa El Sayed and Christian Viau tied for the 4<sup>th</sup> spot, and Professor Viau subsequently withdrew. **The fourth position therefore goes to Mostafa El Sayed.**

To the best of my abilities, these results accurately count all votes cast in the 2025 election for four FED faculty-member representatives on Senate (2025-28). There has been no evidence of vote manipulation or any other unresolved disruption to the electronic voting system.
