

## Entrance Scholarships

- Awarded based on academic merit
- Admission average of 80% or higher
- No application requirement assessed at time of admission
- Must maintain annual average of 80% to renew scholarship

- Supplementary source of funding for students
- Entrance bursaries (new students) and general bursaries (all students) available







- Provide students with additional funds to help meet the direct educational costs of first-year studies
- Deadline to apply was June 30<sup>th</sup>




