

Title:	<i>You're a great leader, but how do you show it?</i>
Theme:	Reflect & Re-Energize
Type of Presentation:	Theory to Practice
Abstract:	Are you an involved student with leadership experience? Whether you volunteer in the community, are part of a CUSA club, or simply are involved on campus, this is the workshop for you! During this session you will learn how to make your leadership experience shine on a resume and cover letter!
Workshop Outcomes:	This session gets students to be able to analyze their previous leadership experience and make meaning of them on a resume. Students will be taught how to use SARS statements to make quantify their experiences and leadership skills
Why is this topic important?:	This is an important topic for SOAR 2018 because it is useful for every type of leader. This session teaches key skills on how students can find value in their experiences and utilize that to further their leadership development!
Presentation Breakdown	
Mini-Lecture:	25 minutes: We will begin with going over important leadership skills that employers look for and we will work through an example of turning an experience into a skill throughout the lecture
Engagement:	Brainstorm and group work (25 minutes) – Students will work in small groups and discuss a relevant leadership experience they have. Students will then help each other create SARS statements about their experiences.
Physical Takeaway:	SARS worksheet with clear examples and self-created statements relevant to their leadership roles.
