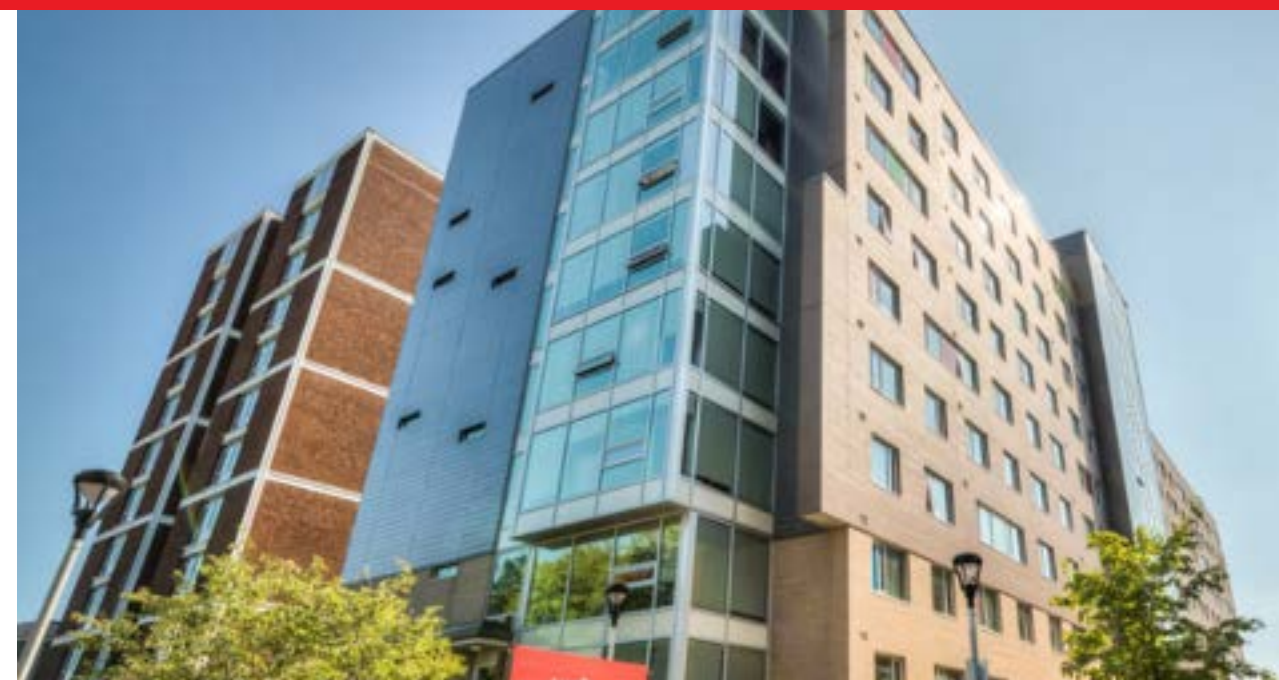

WHAT BUILDING WILL YOU BE LIVING IN?

**FUN FACT: CARLETON RESIDENCE HAS 12 RESIDENCE HOUSES AND
HOUSES AROUND 4000 RESIDENCE EACH YEAR!**



RENFREW & LANARK

The oldest residence buildings, both opening in 1962. Renfrew and Lanark mainly house first year students and has mostly Double Traditional rooms with some Single Traditional rooms.

They are the only residence with no elevators and both have 4 floors. Renfrew is also home to Residence Counselling.



RUSSELL & GRENVILLE

Opened in 1964, Russell and Grenville is another building that mainly houses first-year students. This residence has Double Tradition and Single Traditional rooms. There is also a laundry room located on each floor.

Russell is also home to the Russell Triple Lounge, which is a great space where events are hosted.



GLENGARRY

Opened in 1969, Glengarry is the tallest residence building with 11 floors that house over 600 students.

It also has the most room types including standard Double Traditional rooms, Double Traditional rooms with Communal Washrooms, Three Bedroom Pods and Four Bedroom Pods.

This is the only building with communal washrooms, which are located on every floor.



STORMONT & DUNDAS

Both opened in 1991, Stormont and Dundas is made up of Double Traditional and Single Traditional rooms, which mostly houses first-year students.

With 4 floors each, Stormont and Dundas connect with an outdoor courtyard in the center, which is commonly referred to as the 'fishbowl'.



LENNOX & ADDINGTON

Lennox & Addington has 10 floors and houses a majority of our first-year residents, having 717 students that live here each year.

Features Double-Traditional and Single Traditional rooms but it is the only building to have a Double Traditional room with a private washroom.



RIDEAU

Rideau House is the newest building on campus, only opening in 2025 and houses 450 students. The room styles available are Double-Traditional and Single-Traditional rooms with a shared washroom.

Rideau House is also home to many new spaces for all residents to use. This includes a gym, communal kitchen, study rooms, games & media room and maker space, which are all located on the second floor

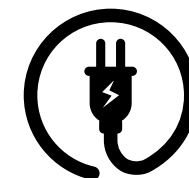

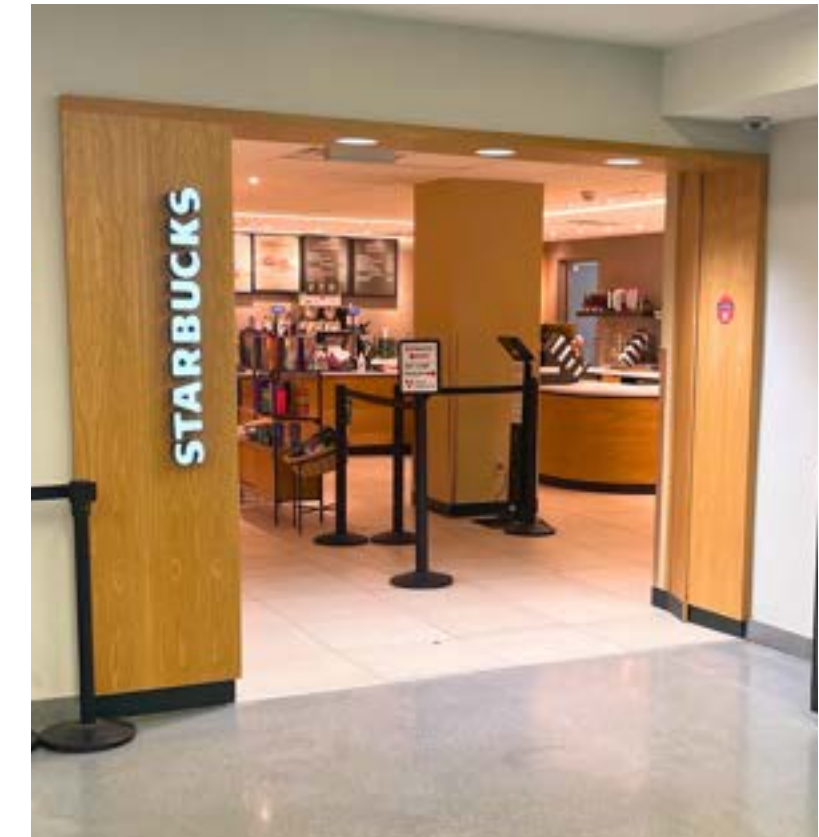
Teraanga Commons Dining Hall

PACKING TIPS

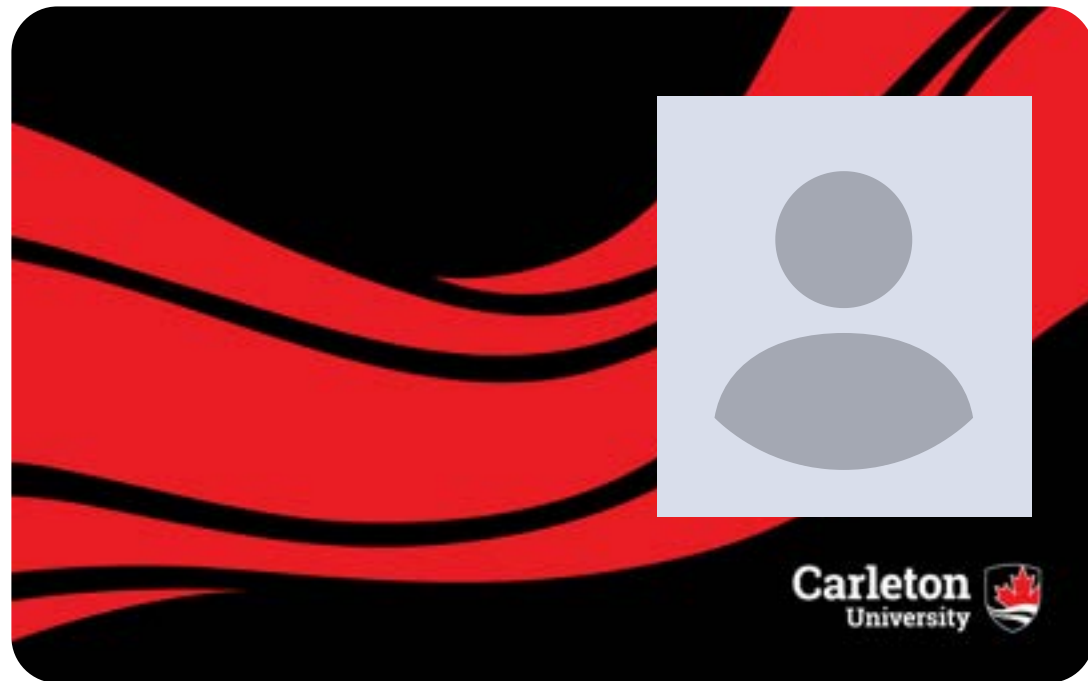
WHAT TO BRING:
