#### **2) Sexual Violence Training Updates –Bailey Reid**

Jenna Easton and Bailey Reid delivered over 50+ trainings this Fall to diverse groups on campus. They also accepted open calls & house calls.

- Highlights:
- Presented to all Varsity Teams
  - Offered three day “I can MANifest Change” training
  - Residence Trainings
  - The Office for Strategic Initiatives has included the Sexual Violence Responding to Disclosures training as a mandatory training as part of their Student Support Certificate
  - Peer Support Volunteers, up and running
  - EAAA Training with Holly as Coordinator

#### **3) Sexual Violence Policy Review**

- Proceeding with Review (see President's email)
- Current stage is asking & accepting feedback through a Design Thinking Workshop, with Quality Initiatives
- Once complete, work is to tease out policy and tactical tools and strategies to apply on campus

#### **4) Campus Strategy on Sexual Violence Prevention**

- Design Workshop offered has open and closed options (e.g. already some groups specifically for Indigenous, LGBTQ+, students with disabilities, TAs, Staff Admin, Staff Man., Cls, Faculty, etc.)
- At this current stage, we are looking for feedback, to build the strategy
- Workplan (policy vs. action plan)
- Feedback will go on website with rationale, dates and agendas for open workshops, feedback from consultation

**5) Discussion of 2018 and beyond in current climate**

- Recent feedback has been on the due process, and innocent until proven guilty. Unanimous concerns that we do not move backwards
- Some trepidation over current political climate, but have funding from the Provincial's Women's Safety Grant and funding for EAAA, Peer Support, Professional Development and Partnership Building until 2019
- The campus survey, as far as we know, has data collected with provincial government and currently frozen
- Open discussions on budget and as a university, what we are ethically obliged to offer
