Co-op after first term third year - tell us by fall term second year

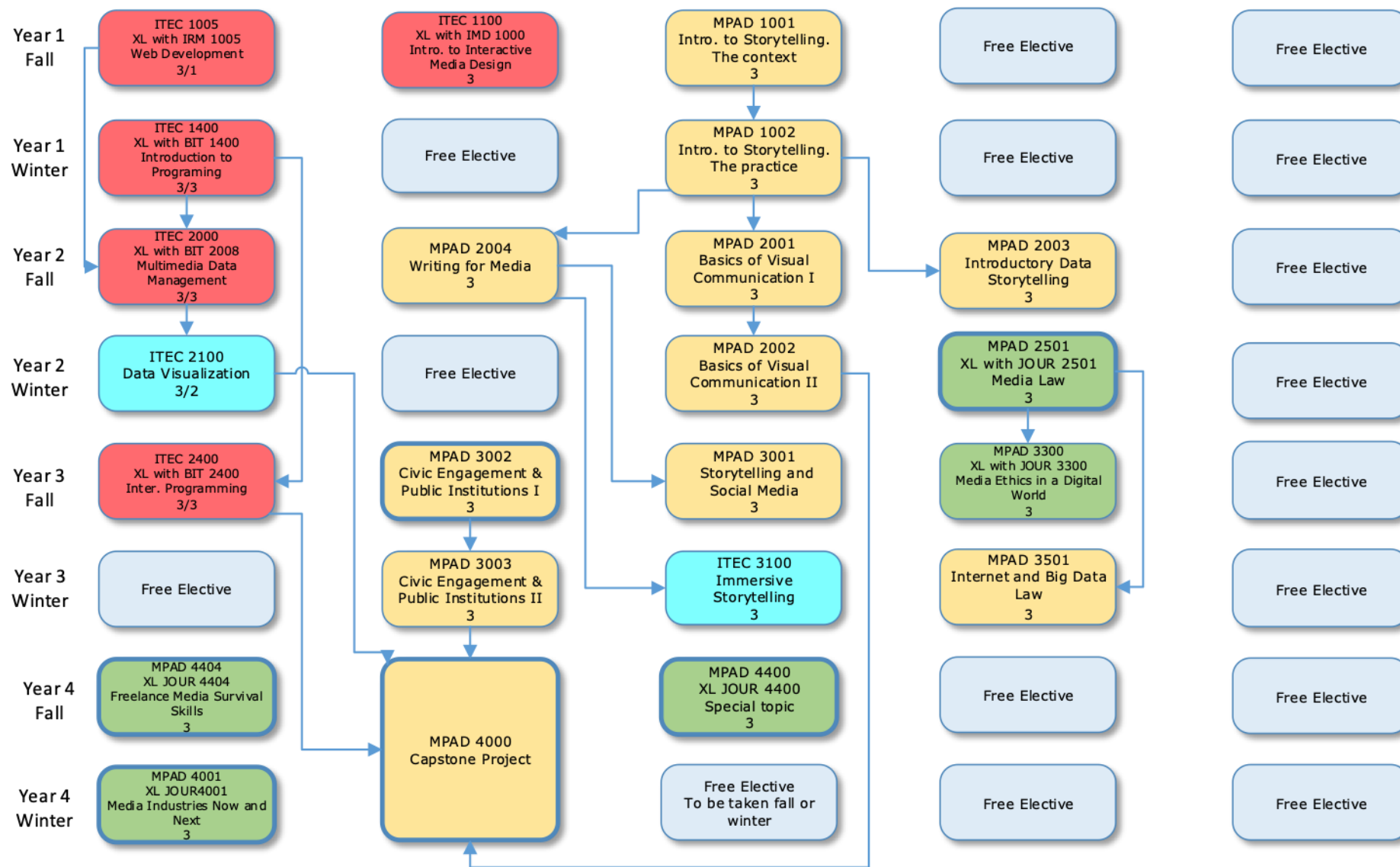
