For positions in **Linguistics** and **Applied Linguistics and Discourse Studies** the required minimum qualifications are a PhD in an appropriate field (usually Linguistics and Applied Linguistics and/or Discourse Studies, respectively) and some successful university teaching experience related to the appropriate field. A desired qualification is experience in course development, including assessment tools.

Application procedure:

Application packages (a written expression of interest plus curriculum vitae) are to be sent to Dr. David Wood at david.wood@carleton.ca. Due to the high volume of applications, these **must be sent electronically** as they are filed electronically for processing – **hard copy materials will not be considered**. In the subject line, please indicate: “Expression of interest: COURSE CODE” (e.g., “Expression of interest: ESLA”; “Expression of interest: LING”; “Expression of interest: ARAB”).

A note to all applicants: As per Article 15.3 of the current CUPE 4600 Unit 2 Collective Agreement, applicants are required to submit an up to date CV, **including a complete listing of all courses taught within the CUPE 4600 Unit 2 bargaining unit at Carleton University**. Candidates are also asked to complete a “Contract Instructor Application Form” available at carleton.ca/provost/wp-content/uploads/CI-Application-FINAL.pdf.

Also, as per Articles 16.3 and 16.4 in the CUPE 4600-2 Collective Agreement, the posted vacancies listed below are first offered to applicants meeting the incumbency criterion.
