

# Your children can participate in a research study about how children learn language!

## What is this study about?

- Children learn language from those around them.
- We want to learn about language learning in school-aged children.
- We especially want to learn more about how parents and siblings help with language learning.

## What do you have to do?

- Tell us about your children and who talks with them (and in what languages).
- Tell a story with your child.

## What do your children have to do?

- Tell some stories based on picture books.
- Listen to some stories that we tell them.

## A little more about the study:

- Approximately 90 minutes (can be divided into two sessions if you prefer).
- Virtual: All appointments will be held over Zoom.

## Who can participate?

- Families who speak only English at home (children in French Immersion are welcome).
- Families who speak another language at home and who have moved to Canada from another country (children who were born in Canada are welcome).
- Families need to have one child who is between 5-8 years old and at least one older child (the older child can be between 5-8 years of age or older).
