### Tenure-Track Position, Department of Sociology

The Department of Sociology at Brandon University is seeking to fill one (1) probationary tenure-track position subject to budget approval. A Ph.D. in Sociology is required at the time of appointment. The successful candidate will be broadly trained in gender and will be required to teach a minimum of two Gender and women's Studies courses (currently Making Sense of Gender and Critical Readings in Gender) as well as sociology courses, at all levels of the undergraduate program, including introductory level courses. Specific courses will be determined based on the needs of the programs and the expertise and specialization of the successful applicant. The ability to contribute to the Department's Crime and Community degree program as well as teaching experience in feminist, critical race, and/or decolonial theories will be seen as assets. Area of research specialization is open; however, candidates are expected to demonstrate a commitment to the sociological examination of gender in their work.
