Call For Papers**

The 7th annual Sociology & Anthropology Graduate Student Caucus (SAGSC) Conference will be held at Carleton University in Ottawa, Ontario on **April 1, 2020**. Organized by the SAGSC Conference Committee at Carleton University, the conference is multidisciplinary and invites submissions from all graduate and senior undergraduate students whose research includes a critically engaged lens of the social (broadly defined).

Registration for this conference is free. **The deadline to submit abstracts is February 3, 2020.**

The types of presentations are as follows:

1. Oral Presentation (15 minutes)
2. Poster Presentation (to be displayed)

Abstract submissions must include the following information:

1. Type of presentation
2. Name and email address for primary presenter(s)
3. Program and University for primary presenter(s)
4. Names of all authors
5. An abstract summary of the research (no more than 200 words)
6. Indicate which conference theme your abstract best fits

Conferences topics include, but are not limited to:

1. Settler colonialism and (de)colonization
2. Critical race, racialization, and ethnicity
3. Environmental issues and climate change
4. Queer and LGBTQIA+ theories and perspectives
5. Intersectional, feminist theories and practices
6. Disability theories, practices, and experiences
7. Intersections of health and the social
