COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will provide an interdisciplinary understanding of and critical perspective on community engagement. Throughout this course, learners will explore what community-engaged research means and how it relates to anti-racist and feminist research. We will engage with diverse participatory methodologies as we critically discuss key ethical and political questions faced by researchers conducting community-engaged research. As we do so, we will problematize the scope and limitations of conducting community-based research.

Learners will have opportunities to engage in vibrant conversations with scholars, activists, and/or social leaders working in Latin America, to discuss weekly topics.
