



## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Centre for Studies on Poverty and Social Citizenship (CSPSC) is currently accepting nominations for candidates to serve on the Centre's Management Committee. The Management Committee is seeking to elect **1-2 student members** to serve two-year terms commencing January 2017.

The Management Committee is responsible for directing and providing vision for the Centre's activities; this includes meeting the Centre's 3 main objectives aimed at generating critical and innovative knowledge about poverty and social citizenship: (1) supporting and partnering with local, provincial, national and international organizations; (2) disseminating the results of the Centre's research or research conducted by other organizations; and (3) creating and supporting research opportunities for social work students. The Management Committee currently consists of 11 Committee Members, including the Centre Chair, 6 Carleton faculty members, 2 representatives of professional social work associations and 2 members representing social welfare organizations from within the Ottawa Region.

Within the role of Committee Member, each elected candidate will hold the responsibility of attending Management Committee meetings and participate in subcommittees to study and pursue Centre projects. Management Committee membership is considered a volunteer role.

Eligible candidates must be currently studying in Carleton's School of Social in either the BSW, MSW or PhD program and have a unique interest in furthering the Centre's mission, goal and objectives.
