- **One-on-One Appointments** offer assistance for students with learning and writing questions. Learning support sessions address topics such as procrastination, time management, academic reading, and study skills. Writing consultation sessions focus specifically on Carleton course assignments at any stage of the writing process to build transferable skills.
- **How to... from 10 - 2** is a drop-in service offered Monday-Thursday from 10am – 2pm. Students can come to CSAS (4th floor MacOdrum Library) with questions about writing- or learning-related tasks. Students will receive resources and referrals about their questions.
- **Incentive Program** provides students in supported courses the opportunity to gain a course incentive by completing Learning & Writing Support Workshops offered on **Brightspace**. Students can self-enrol via the **Online Resources** page. <https://carleton.ca/csas/online-support/>

- **PASS** offers course-specific weekly study sessions and Q & As led by peer facilitators. Each study session has an associated worksheet that is accessible through Brightspace and can be used as a study tool throughout the term. This service also offers review sessions, mock exams, and office hours. PASS is offered during the fall and winter semesters.
