### FINAL PROJECTS

WHAT AND HOW?



- Do you have a <u>final project</u> for your course (e.g., take-home exam, assignment, group project)?

   <u>video</u> going through the final project, including

### COMMUNICATION

**BE CONSISTENT** 



- Are you maintaining regular <u>communication</u> with your students (e.g., Monday morning messages, mid-week check-ins)?
- Are you still answering general student questions over email? Be consistent about how you answer questions & save time (i.e., only when they are posted to the Ask the Instructor forum)

- Have you considered using <u>Poll Everywhere</u> or <u>Zoom polls</u> to get anonymous <u>feedback</u> from students on the content, pace, assessments, etc.?
