Emergency Management and Continuity of Operations Resources

- Know what to do before, during, and after an emergency (Emergency Procedures)
- Stay informed when an emergency happens through Carleton University's <u>Emergency</u> Notification System
- Participate in online and community-based training opportunities to learn more about how to prepare for emergencies, understand roles and responsibilities, and what decisive action to take in an emergency (<u>Training Opportunities</u>)
- Keep you and your students safe by being familiar with the fire and life safety at Carleton (<u>Fire Protection Program</u>)
- Learn more about how you can be prepared at home and at work (<u>#CUReady:</u> <u>Emergency Preparedness</u>)

Environmental Health and Safety Resources

- Complete your mandatory Health and Safety training (<u>Employee Training</u>)
- Report an injury to you or a student, an incident or a good catch in <u>CUWorksafe</u>
- Consult the Violence and Harassment Prevention Programs for guidance and support (Workplace Violence and Harassment)
- Engage with Health and Safety through your union representative on the <u>Joint Health</u> and Safety Committee
- Schedule an ergonomic assessment of your workstation to prevent injury (Ergonomics)

Risk and Insurance Resources
