In May 2023, BigBlueButton (BBB) will no longer be available in Brightspace. Brightspace users will no longer be able to create and host new BBB sessions in their course. Please download and save any materials from past BBB sessions before April 30, 2023.

Early Innovation – A TLS Story from the Past

We're celebrating our 30th anniversary! To help recognize this milestone, we're sharing stories of teaching and learning from our past.

<u>The first story in our series</u> focuses on Prof. Tim Patterson and his approaches to teaching that challenged his students and pushed them outside of

their comfort zone. In the mid-90s, rather than produce a paper, Tim gave students in his third-year evolutionary paleoecology class the option to produce a website at a time when the world wide web was still a very new concept. In many ways Tim was a pioneer for many teaching and learning approaches that we know are important to student engagement and success.
