Dear President Bacon,

We are writing to you today to call for immediate action at every level of the university to make our campus safer and more inclusive for transgender, non-binary, and gender diverse members of Carleton's community. These 43 Calls to Action over are designed to rectify the harm that trans students, faculty, and staff currently face on campus, ensure Carleton meets its obligations under the Ontario Human Rights Code, and reshape Carleton University into a place that puts trans safety and inclusion at the forefront of its priorities.

These Calls to Action are a summary of demands that were submitted to Carleton University on January 12, 2018 and February 1, 2019--more than 2 1/2 years ago. We view these calls as the bare minimum that Carleton must do to stop actively harming trans and nonbinary people and meet its human rights obligations under Ontario law. We hope that the structures put in place in response to these demands will enable us to dream bigger and create a place where trans and nonbinary people can thrive.

We know Carleton is a place that celebrates diversity and equity in all its forms, and these Calls to Action will push the university in that direction. We look forward to working with you to make Carleton's campus a safe, welcoming place for all of its students, faculty, and staff - not just those whose gender identity conforms to societal norms.
