Standards of Behaviour

All Virtual Ventures community members must abide by Carleton University's statement on conduct and human rights policies and procedures. In addition they must:

- Respect and comply with all Virtual Ventures Program Policies and Procedures
- Demonstrate values of honesty, caring, responsibility and respect
- Treat one another with dignity and respect at all times and especially when there is a disagreement
- Not inflict or encourage others to inflict harm (either bodily or emotional) on others
- Take appropriate measures to help those in need and if necessary seek staff assistance to resolve conflict peacefully
- Respect persons who are in a position of leadership (volunteers and all virtual ventures staff)
- All Virtual Ventures community members may not under any circumstances:
 - Use any offensive language
 - Share any adult material with inappropriate content, including but not limited to offensive language, violence, or nudity, etc
 - Harass, discriminate or bully other campers, volunteers or staff members

Live Engagement

I acknowledge that while participating in live online programs (optional), online collaboration will make my child's environment audible and visible to other participants, and I commit to providing a space from which my child can participate that is supportive and free from inappropriate content or situations, including violence, profanity, and nudity.

I agree to not photograph or record any live engagement sessions, to respect the privacy of all participants and leaders.

Consequences
